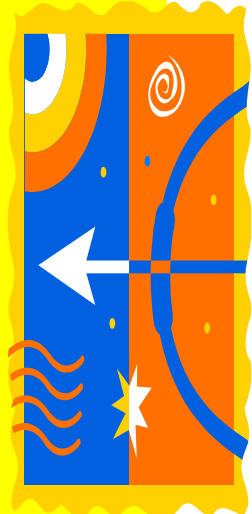

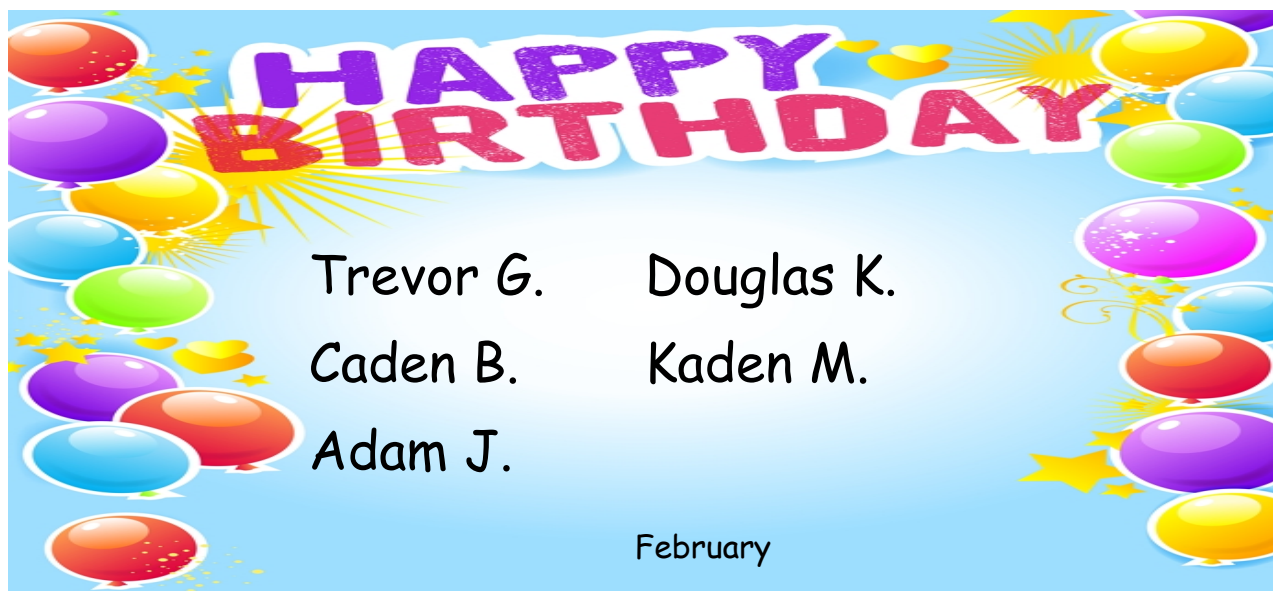
Volunteers still needed for Friday track set-up and Saturday concessions.

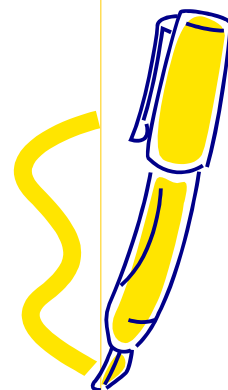
