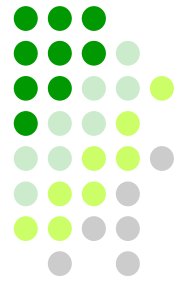

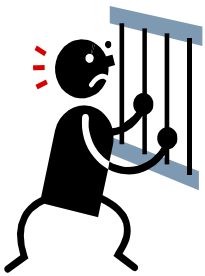


## Den of the Month Den 2 Tigers Leaders Randy K. and Chris J.

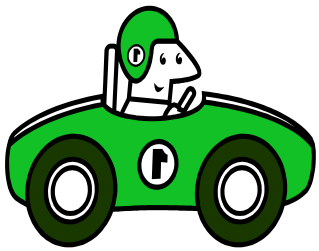
