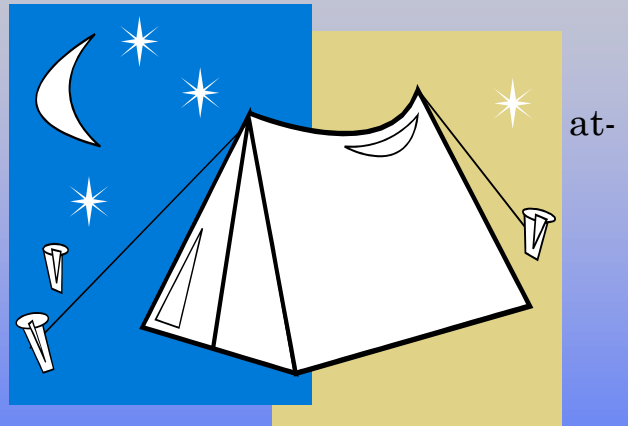
Our dates are set for Camp Rokolio and Camp Twin Lakes 2012!
